

Summer Intern Announcement – Community/Urban Forestry

Dakota Dunes Community Improvement District (CID) is seeking a candidate to fill a summer intern roll in the field of Community or Urban Forestry. The successful candidate will assist in the development and implementation of a Community Tree Management Plan.
