Dakota Dunes Rising River Update 4

Change in Releases

New River projections have become available. The latest Big Sioux River projections from the National Weather Service is now at 35 feet which should equate to an elevation of 1093. A physical survey of the Big Sioux Levee indicates an elevation of 1098 not the previously reported 1093. This peak should run Sunday afternoon through Monday night.

The Missouri River projections are very similar to the previous update with elevations ranging from 1091-1092. The Missouri River should peak between Saturday afternoon and Sunday evening. Corp releases have not changed as of the writing of this update.

Also, as with most flood events, conditions change rapidly. Conditions still warrant possible voluntary evacuation. Additional measures may have to be taken to close off sanitary sewers in low lying areas to help preserve the system as a whole so please stay tuned for further updates.
