Dakota Dunes Rising River Update 7

At approximately 2:00 am on Sunday morning, it appeared there could be water over the top of the banks on the Missouri River in the Spyglass area, which would have impacted residents south of the Meadows, west of the Dakota Dunes Blvd and the Willows area.

For resident safety and the possibility of utility failure, it was decided to issue an evacuation notice for this area.

A team of law enforcement, fire department volunteers and others went door to door advising those affected residents of the evacuation process.

At 8:45 am, we notified those residents that they may return home.

Conditions can change rapidly and the river elevations are high, but should reduce over the next few days, based on the Corp release schedule.

We appreciate the cooperation of those residents impacted during the early Sunday morning hours. We continue to monitor the situation with equipment in place and manpower on site and on call, should the situation require further action for preventative measures and river elevations.
