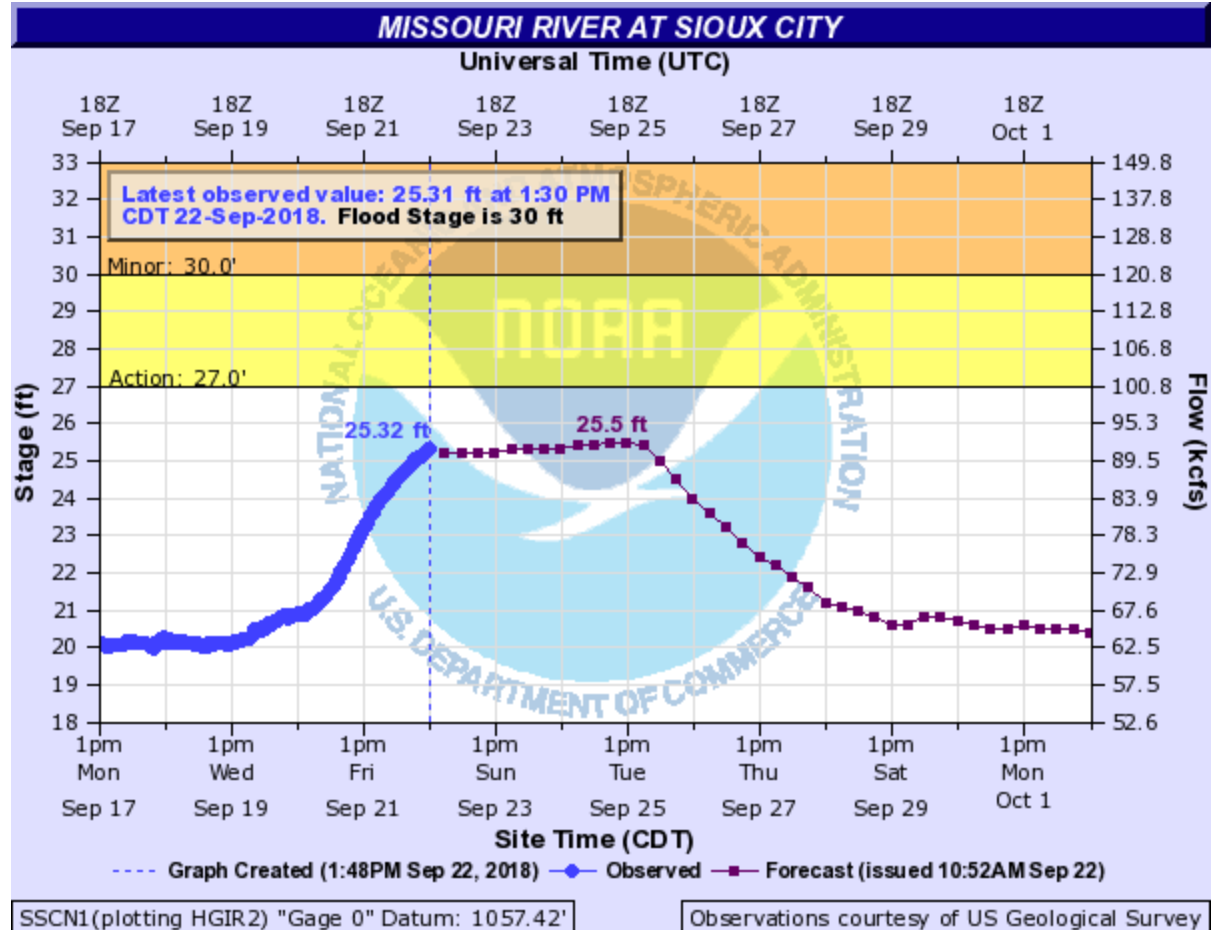


Missouri/Big Sioux River Update 9/22/18

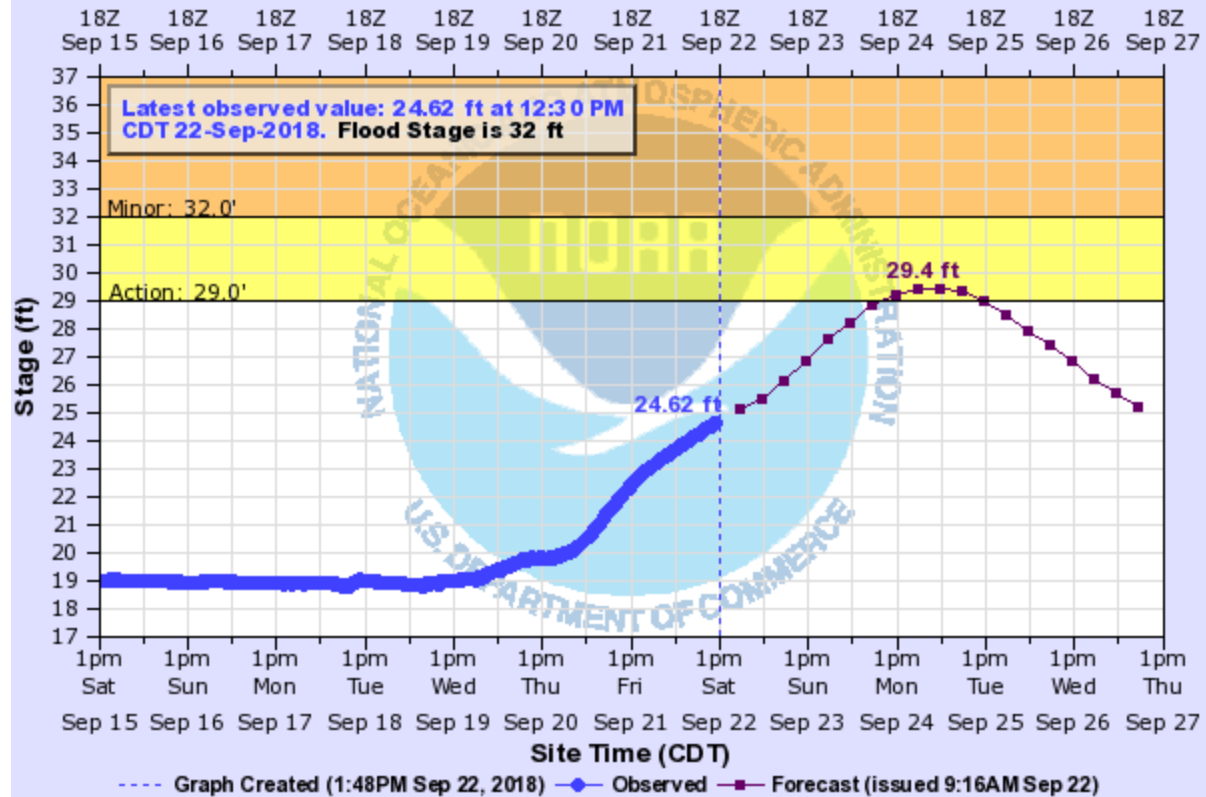
The most recent update from the NWS shows a peak Missouri River stage of 25.5 at Sioux City. As you can see the current river stage is 25.32 so the peak is about here (according to NWS). We had an elevation reading at 9 am this morning and at hole 8 we recorded 1084.5. We have not seen any major issues at this time. We will continue to monitor through the weekend. The peak will remain through Tuesday.



The Big Sioux River is set to crest on late Monday or early Tuesday. The crest is projected at a river stage 29.4 at NSC. This is a couple feet lower than earlier in the summer, but with the higher Missouri River we could see higher water surface elevations. We saw 1084 earlier this summer, we may see 1086 in this event. The levee is at an elevation of 1097. We do not anticipate any problems at these elevations.
