### **River Update**

As you may know, the Corps of Engineers has increased releases on the Missouri River from 55,000 cfs to 60,000 cfs due to heavy rain in western SD and Nebraska. As conditions exist now, they expect releases to remain at 60,000 cfs for at least the next three weeks. With this release level and what is projected to come from the James, Vermillion and Big Sioux Rivers, the National Weather Service (NWS) is currently projecting a River Stage of 24 feet at Sioux City by Saturday May 25<sup>th</sup>. Past history indicates that this river stage would equate to an elevation of between 1084 and 1085 at Dakota Dunes. We do not anticipate any issues at these elevations. As projections and conditions change, we will provide further updates.
