Dakota Dunes River Update

The National Weather Service is currently projecting the river stage at Sioux City to go to 26.1 feet by Tuesday, May 28th. Last night's rainfall across southwest SD is pushing the Big Sioux, James and Vermillion Rivers up which is causing the rise. As of this time, the Gavin's Point Releases are still at 60,000 CFS. This could change in the coming days depending on inflows upstream. The projected 26.1 river stage should generate water surface elevations of between approximately 1086.3 and 1087. While we do not anticipate problems at these elevations, we are taking preventive measures as we have in the past in the event the projected river stage rises. We will continue to communicate changes to you.
