River Update

According to the National Weather Service April 19th projection, the Missouri River is expected to crest at a 25 foot River Stage at Sioux City. The crest should happen over the weekend and then start receding early next week. The 25 foot River Stage should equate to a water surface elevation of between 1085 and 1086. At this time, we do not see any issues at these levels. We will be monitoring this over the weekend. The Big Sioux River should stay steady at its current level through the weekend. It appears the Big Sioux River at Akron will peak over the weekend and begin to recede. We should see this recession into next week.

We are currently removing temporary sandbag levees on Pebble Beach at Hole 8 and replacing it with a permanent berm at similar elevations so that that protection is of a more permanent nature. The trucks you are seeing in that area are to complete that project. We hope to complete this project early next week. We will be conducting a similar process on Bay Hill Circle, where we had temporary flood protection installed by Hole 8 green. As construction proceeds in these areas, please avoid walking in that area to allow safe completion of work.
